## CBT Exam - Shifts, Timings, Marks, Pattern

CBT January 2026 will be a computer-based exam of total 1.5 hours (90 minutes) duration with two papers, held one after the other on the same day & slot.

**The exam/s can be held in any one of the 3 shifts :**

Shift	Reporting time	Entry timings	CBT timings
Morning	7.30 am	7.45 - 8.15 am	8.30 - 10.00 am
Afternoon	10.30 am	10.45- 11.15 am	11.30 - 1.00 pm
Evening	1.30 pm	1.45 - 2.15 pm	2.30 - 4.00 pm

### **Paper 1 : Verbal & Non-Verbal Reasoning - 20 minutes**

- will test Verbal & Non-Verbal Reasoning
- will be of 20 minutes with 15 MCQs
- will be in English medium

### **Paper 2 : Main Subject paper (of the post applied) – 70 minutes**

- will test knowledge of the subject/post applied for
- will be of 70 minutes with 40 MCQs
- will be in English medium except Regional languages, Hindi & Sanskrit

Note : There will be no negative marking.

## KIND ATTENTION TGT SCIENCE & TGT SOCIAL SCIENCE CANDIDATES!

● TGT Science : On the day of exam, a choice will be given between Physics, Chemistry & Biology. Candidates will choose any 2 out of the 3 subjects and CBT exam will be based on the 2 selected subjects only.

● TGT Social Science : On the day of exam, a choice will be given between Geography, History+Political Science and Economics. Candidates will choose any 2 out of the 3 subjects and CBT exam will be based on the 2 selected subjects only.

● will be in English medium except Regional languages, Hindi & Sanskrit

### Mandatory Items:

Candidates will not be allowed entry inside the centre without the following mandatory documents:

- Print/Hard Copy of Admit Card
- 1 recent, coloured passport size photograph of the candidate
- Original Photo identity proof with candidate's name and photo (matching with name and photo on Admit Card) issued by Government – PAN card/Driving License/Voter ID/Passport/Aadhar Card/ E-Aadhar etc. (with photograph)

### Prohibited Items:

Candidates will not be allowed entry inside the centre without the following mandatory documents:

- Candidates will not be allowed to take the following items inside the centre :
- Any stationery item – such as textual material (printed or written), bits of papers, Calculator, Pen Drives, Calculator, Log Table, Electronic Pen/Scanner, etc.
- Any communication device – such as Smart watch, Mobile Phone, Bluetooth, Earphones, Microphone, Pager, Health Band, Camera, etc.
- Other items like Wallet, Goggles, Handbags, pouches, etc.
- Any eatable item opened or packed, except for diabetic candidates
- Any other item which could be used for unfair means
