SUB: Dengue: Prevention and Control-Reg.

Sir/Madam,

You may aware that Dengue syndrome has become a global health issue these days as it is endemic in more than 100 countries. Over the last decades, Dengue fever has emerged as a major cause of illness and death worldwide. The disease is caused by Dengue viruses which got transmitted to human by bites of infected *Aedes mosquitoes*. The Aedes mosquitoes generally thrive in tropical / sub tropical countries and in India the span of June to August is considered as Dengue Infection Period. Though medicine / vaccine are available for this deadly disease, yet, as we all know- '**Prevention is better than Cure**'.

The Government has been taking every care for prevention and control of Dengue for which various initiatives are being undertaken by the appropriate Government Authorities. Recently, under National Health Mission, State Health Department of Uttarakhand and other Government Departments located in the State as well as Educational Institutions has come forward to create awareness amongst public at large about prevention and control measures for Dengue. To prevent the dengue, the following awareness-cum-preventive measures should be taken:-

1. All Educational Institutions to destroy probable threat places for breeding of mosquitoes in their school/premises.
2. Spread awareness in students / parents about prevention and control of dengue during assembly, PTM and organizing various competitions on Dengue topic.
3. Circulate Dengue awareness related message / information to parents thru SMS.
4. Participation of Principals / Teachers and Students in Dengue Prevention Awareness programme at Block, Division and District Level.
5. Advise to students to wear full sleeves dresses during the Dengue Infection Period (June to August), so that a large part of the body should remain covered.

With this letter, I am forwarding herewith a **PPT and Report Card** made available by the Olo Mission Director, National Health Mission, Government of Uttarakhand with request to widely disseminate this information amongst your school students to broaden awareness about prevention and control of Dengue in the larger National interest.
